



Mulberry Canine behavioural consultations

If you are experiencing difficulties with your dog, then ask your Veterinary surgeon to refer you to a qualified Canine behaviour counsellor.

An appointment with Sarah Marsh Dip.CABT (COAPE) will be arranged either at your home, or at our private clinic outside Beaconsfield. The first consultation usually takes approximately two hours, during which time your dogs behaviour and training history will be discussed. Following this session, you will receive a written assessment and detailed practical treatment plan. This plan will be reward based, force-free and tailored to suit your individual family dog. Your referring Vet will also receive a written report.
